Ms Catherine Mokgatle-Makwakwa, a retired nurse since 2004, currently a director of Lefika La Botshabelo Orphans and Vulnerable Children Centre, a Ministry of Saint Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church in Tshwane. She is a graduate of the University of the North, where she obtained the Diploma in Nursing Education as well as the University of South Africa, where she obtained the degree Bachelor of Arts in Nursing Science majoring in Nursing Administration and Community Health Nursing. She is currently serving on the South African Dental Technicians Council, appointed by the Minister of Health representing the public. She was further appointed by the Minister of Health as a member of the National Nursing Summit Organizing Committee in 2010. In 2011 the Minister once again appointed her as a member of Nursing Education and Training Task Team, tasked with implementation of the recommendations of the National Nursing Summit. She also served on the South African Nursing Council appointed by the Minister of Health for two terms.
